Spirituality or Spiritual Truth

“Evil people and impostors will go on from bad to worse,” 2Timothy 3:13 warns, “deceiving and being deceived.” This cycle of deception is nowhere more clearly seen than in the false spirituality rampant in American religion.

The current issue of the *Gospel Advocate* has four excellent articles addressing the danger of spiritual seduction and the need to build on spiritual truth rather than on counterfeit spirituality.

We must carefully evaluate current trends to avoid being blown off course by the deception of fabricated spirituality.

Any practice which purports to build a deeper spirituality, but which is not rooted in Scripture, is a fraud. Such practices are spiritual manipulation. They do not promote spiritual growth, but are merely spiritual deception. As Paul writes in Colossians 2:8,

See to it that no one takes you captive by philosophy and empty deceit, according to human tradition, according to the elemental spirits of the world, and not according to Christ.

Spiritual truth is the only basis of true spirituality. When the simple truth of Scripture is eclipsed by emotionalism, or by mysticism, or by theatrics, apostasy is waiting in the wings.

Returning to the word of God, the Bible, we can find all we need to be the men and women of faith God has called us to be.

Elders' Corner

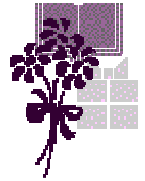

Never before in the history of the world have we seen a mental health phenomenon like we see developing in our nation today. All around us a terrible epidemic is sweeping our land mostly unseen and unnoticed. Depression is nothing new. Thousands of years ago, the Psalmist penned the words that could only have come from the soul of one who had personally done battle with depression. I have found no description anywhere that compares to the clarity of these words.

*My tears have been my food
day and night,*

*These things I remember
as I pour out my soul:
how I used to go with the multitude,
leading the procession to the house of God,
with shouts of joy and thanksgiving
among the festive throng.*

*Why are you downcast, O my soul?
Why so disturbed within me?*

It is estimated that by 2020, depression will be the second most common cause of death in America after heart disease. It is estimated that depression costs our economy \$51 Billion a year (in comparison, alcoholism contributes to about negative \$1 Billion a year). Today, 18.8 million men and women suffer with diagnosed depression and the vast majority of those meeting the criteria will never be diagnosed. Sadly, the fastest growing population in which depression is seen is in those under the age of 5.

These are staggering and frightening statistics. But, even in the shadow of this there is good news. In the Word of God we find hope and assurance as we face, privately in our own lives and collectively as God's people, this epidemic.

In the weeks to come, I will be using this space to provide some encouragement and hope from scripture for those that suffer with depression. I invite you to keep these articles to share with your friends and family members that may need them. Stay tuned for good news from God's Word.
